We contracted with Mecosta County Road Commission to gravel the following roads this summer. These projects should begin around June 14, 2021 and be completed near July 1, 2021.

Polk from 130th east ¼ Mile 170th 9 Mile to ½ North 160th Buchanan to 10 Mile 140th Buchanan to 4200' North 8 Mile 135th to ¼ Mile east Buchanan 155th to 160th 165th 6 Mile to Polk 150th 6 Mile to 7 Mile 135th Pierce to 8 Mile 6 Mile 130th to Northland Drive

We contracted with Michigan Chloride Sales to brine our 26 miles of gravel roads. The first one was completed on May 7, 2021, and the second one will be done around July 1, 2021.
