- 1. Fire Department and First Responder Report: The next Fire Board Meeting will be tomorrow night, March 16, 2016 at 7 p.m. at the Mecosta Austin Fire Hall. The Fire Department received a \$350.00 donation from the Amish for the fire on 140th Avenue.
- 2. Assessor and Supervisor Report: There was one petition at the Board of Review. There will be BOR hours tomorrow, March 16, 2016, from 1:00-4:00 p.m. and from 6:00-9:00 p.m. There were three Veterans applied for. There are still problems with the GIS mapping. The maps are just not accurate.
- 3. Treasurer's Report: 91% of taxpayers have paid 96% of the tax dollars for the summer taxes. 83% of taxpayers have paid 94% of the tax dollars for the winter taxes. The Tax Account is balanced. The Township Operating, Interest and Penalties taxes received will be invested.
- 4. Clerk's Report: The Presidential Primary Election went very well. We did not experience any problems. The Township is signed up with a tax free account with Amazon. Great Lakes Office Supply has a new website to place orders. They are encouraging all their customers to try it out to streamline the process of placing orders.
